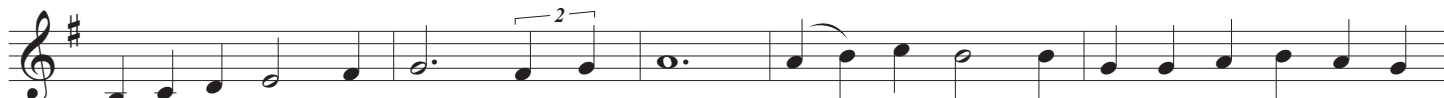

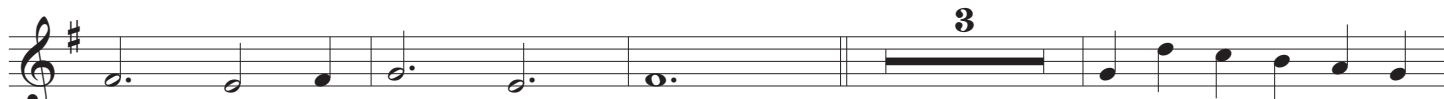

COMPOSER'S NOTE: This unified setting of the liturgy was commissioned by the interim pastor and people of my first parish in Pittsburgh, Holy Emmanuel Lutheran Church, a congregation of the Slovak Zion Synod of the ELCA. Although dwindling in numbers, the congregation continued to sing robustly and demonstrated their openness to mission by commissioning a new musical setting of the liturgy based on my already published Sanctus setting at ELW 189. In 2015 the people of Holy Emmanuel made the painful decision to close the church. I was present for the final service as the people sang this setting for the final time with passion and hope for the future. The song and mission of Holy Emmanuel continue to this day through singers like you who have taken up this music. For you I have added two versions of the alternate Hymn of Praise, "This Is the Feast" and, on the next page, "Worthy Is Christ." The Holy Emmanuel Liturgy was and is intended solely for the glory of God and for the revitalization of worship through believers' songs of praise and prayer.
